**CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING-**Last Sunday evening the church met in business session to discuss and vote on the future of the multipurpose building project. Presentations were made

by Dan Binder on two possible building configurations and Andy Engdahl on the financial repercussions of each design. These presentations were followed by a lot of guestions and answers plus a great deal of general discussion. For the project to continue, there needed to be a 66% majority vote and the final vote was at 88% for continuing the project with the 40'X60' building for an estimated cost of \$500,000. The building committee will now begin more specific work focusing on this choice of building size and will be bringing presentations to the congregation at appropriate intervals. 
